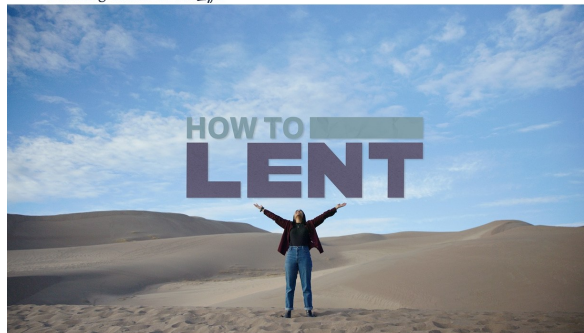

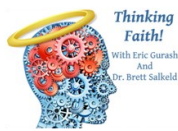

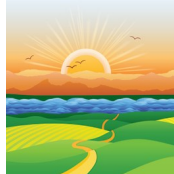
Brett Salkeld and Thomas Harmon on Ordo Amoris - Part 3

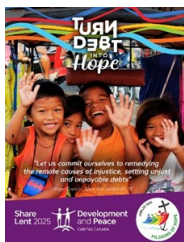

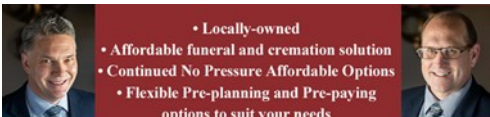
