

LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

Training sessions will be provided.

Liturgy Committee: Assist in coordinating the Liturgical Year
NEW CONTINUING

Ministers of Holy Communion: Responsible for the set-up of the gifts & credence table, assist with the distribution of holy communion, and prepare vessels for next Mass
NEW CONTINUING

Lector (Reader): Proclaim the First or Second Readings, read the Prayers of the Faithful, and the Announcements
NEW CONTINUING

Altar Server (Grade 4 and up, including adults)
Carry the cross/candles during the procession and during the gospel reading, hold the missal, prepare and clear the altar
NEW CONTINUING

Greeter/Usher: greet parishioners and visitors as they arrive for Mass and seat them in the assembly, bring forward the offerings of bread and wine at the Offertory, take up the collection, direct the people during the Communion Rite, distribute the bulletins and tidy up the pews after Mass

Liturgy of the Word with Children:
Guide children aged 4-7 through the Liturgy of the Word with a provided outline that is at a child's level of understanding. (September through May)
